About FOSS for All Conference



The first edition of FOSS for All Conference is a non-profit open source community event under the slogan “Free and Open Source Software for All.” Our goal is to create an open source conference for everyone.

Globally, non-profit open source conferences like COSCUP (Taiwan) and FOSDEM (Belgium) are thriving, nurturing their local open source ecosystems. In Korea, large global open source projects such as Python, Golang, Ubuntu, OpenStack, and Kubernetes can organize their own conferences with sponsors, but smaller projects and individuals face challenges in hosting technical exchange events. FOSS for All was launched to help foster the domestic open source ecosystem by bringing together diverse open source projects in Korea.

FOSS for All is open to anyone interested in open source software and communities—developers, contributors, designers, translators, planners, and more. The conference will feature technical talks, community booths, panel discussions, and various programs for sharing experiences and knowledge.

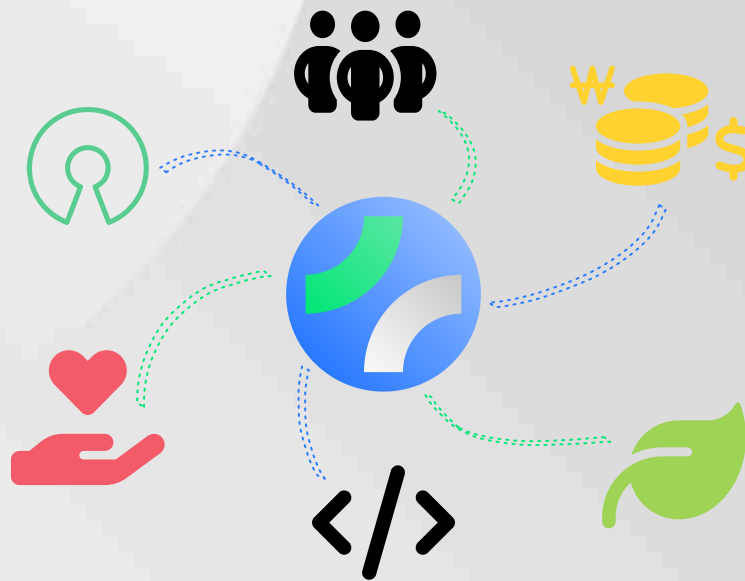

About FOSS for All



An initiative to build sustainable FOSS ecosystem in Korea and beyond

FOSS for All is an initiative launched by various domestic and international communities and projects to build a sustainable free/open source ecosystem. Starting with small non-profit registration via tax authority and the first conference, we aim to establish a non-profit corporation, obtain public interest status, and build networks among projects, communities, companies, and users.

Through these efforts, we hope to support open source projects and communities in Korea and worldwide, so they can focus on what matters without the burden of paperwork or administration, contributing to a sustainable open source ecosystem.

Main Goals and Projects

Fiscal Sponsorship

We aim to provide fiscal sponsorship so that open source communities and projects can receive and manage funds transparently and conveniently, even without establishing a legal entity. This is a mid- to long-term goal after establishing a non-profit corporation.

FOSS for All Conference

We plan to hold annual conferences where various open source communities can gather, share experiences, and discuss common and new challenges. This will encourage more active and sustainable participation and contribution to open source projects.

Building Networks Among Ecosystem Participants

We will build networks among maintainers, contributors, enthusiasts, users, companies, and organizations in the open source ecosystem, acting as a catalyst for collaboration and support.

The event will be held at Kwangwoon University, a comprehensive private university in Seoul known for its practical software education, student-led open source projects (KW Open Source Group), and experience hosting international open source conferences.

Kwangwoon University also hosted VideoLAN's Video Dev Day in 2024, demonstrating its capacity for large-scale events—making it an ideal venue for FOSS for All Conference.

Logo Exposure

- **Banner:** Sponsor logos will be displayed on banners at the venue entrance, lecture halls, and other locations.
- **Website:** Sponsor logos will be displayed in the sponsor section of the conference website.
- **Badge:** Sponsor logos will be printed on attendee badges for effective exposure.

Interaction

- **Sponsor Session**
 - A great opportunity to share your open source technology experiences, projects, or team culture.
 - Sessions must be related to open source technology and comply with the code of conduct. Excessive product promotion is prohibited.
 - Sponsor sessions will be marked as such on the website and other media.
- **Sponsor Booth:** Promote your company and interact directly with participants at your booth. Booth events and mini-sessions are possible, allowing you to promote your products and services.
- **Ticket Support:** Complimentary or discounted tickets are provided according to sponsorship tier, allowing easy interaction with participants.

Marketing

- **Social Media Promotion:** Sponsor promotional posts will be uploaded to FOSS for All's social media.
- **Break Video Promotion:** Sponsor promotional videos will be played during session breaks.
- **Attendee List Provided**
 - After the event, we provide attendee data so you can interact with participants.
 - Only information from attendees who consented to third-party sharing will be provided, and the data provided varies by sponsorship tier.
 - In accordance with the conference's privacy policy, you must provide your company name, address, sponsor contact information, purpose of use, retention period, and disposal method after expiration for inclusion in the privacy policy.

Common

- **Certificate of Appreciation:** As a token of our gratitude for your sponsorship, we will present a certificate to commemorate your participation as a conference sponsor.



Sponsor Registration Process

Select & Discuss Sponsorship Package

Choose your desired sponsorship package and submit the sponsor registration form. If available, we will proceed with registration. If you wish to adjust package details or provide in-kind sponsorship (goods, equipment, or services), please consult with the organizing committee. In-kind sponsors receive benefits proportional to the cash value of their contribution.

Issuance of Sponsorship Documents

- Quotation – Issued upon request for internal approval processes.
- Contract – Drafted if required by the sponsor. Can be omitted if not needed.
- Tax Invoice (or Invoice) – Issued under the name "FOSS for All" after contract completion or, if the contract is omitted, after internal approval. For overseas corporations without a domestic office, an invoice will be issued instead.

Payment of Sponsorship Fee

After the tax invoice (or invoice) is issued, please transfer the sponsorship fee (including 10% VAT) to the designated account. The payment deadline is specified in the contract, or within two weeks of invoice issuance if no contract is made. Extensions are possible upon request, but payment must be completed at least three weeks before the event.

Completion of Sponsor Registration

Once registration is complete, your logo will be posted on the website and you will be guided on how to use your sponsor benefits. Sponsorship funds are used for venue rental, badge and souvenir production, meals, video streaming and recording equipment, and other event expenses. Any remaining funds will be used for other FOSS for All activities or administrative costs.
